Peace is considered a state of serenity in the absence of conflict and problems.




What are institutions?



'Peace, Justice, and Strong Institutions'

Significance of peace, justice, and strong institutions

- Peace, justice, and strong institutions is meaningful in its efforts to protect human rights
- Promote peace, and provide access to justice for every individual in the global community

03. Goal of the international community for promoting peace and building strong institutions

SDGs 16. Targets

- 16.1 Significantly reduce all forms of violence and related death rates everywhere
- 16.2 End abuse, exploitation, trafficking and all forms of violence against and torture of children
- 16.4 By 2030, significantly reduce illicit financial and arm flows, strengthen the recovery and return of stolen assets and combat all forms of organized crime
- 16.6 Develop effective, accountable and transparent institutions at all levels
- 16.8 Broaden and strengthen the participation of developing countries in the institutions of global governance
- 16.10 Ensure public access to information and protect fundamental freedoms, in accordance with national legislation and international agreements

FGM, the most brutal form of control over women



FGM is legally banned in 22 African countries






